

BSN FACULTY SUPPLY

Pre-licensure BSN programs had 942 full-time and 1,138 part-time faculty in AY 2017-18. Programs reported 96 FT and 26 PT vacancies and a perceived need for 85 more FT BSN faculty positions not currently included in their budget.

BSN EDUCATION PROGRAMS

In Fall 2018, there were 76 active prelicensure BSN programs in Florida.

Responding programs reported students enrolled in 45 generic BSN programs, 20 second degree BSN programs, 37 RN to BSN programs. In total, 19,100 students were reported to be enrolled in a BSN program, and almost 7,800 graduated from a BSN program in AY 2017–18.


BSN NCLEX PASSAGE RATES



89% of BSN graduates passed the NCLEX in 2018.

Public programs had a higher success rate (94%), followed by non-profit private programs (91%), and private, for-profit programs (83%).

Florida's combined public program passage rate exceeded the 2018 national average (91.6%) for BSN programs.
