- Review report titled “Analysis of Nurse Licensure Data: Methods and Statewide Results” before interpreting or reporting regional statistics.
- Nurses analyzed have active licenses with statuses rendering them eligible to practice, report a Florida address as their mailing address or work address, and did not report a practice location outside the state of Florida.
- When nurses provided unique information for practice location, they have been placed according to the region in which they work (about 40% of cases). In the remainder of cases, nurses are placed according to the mailing address they gave, which may be a home or work address.
- Statewide, about 8% of nurses are missing data on gender and about 10% are missing data on race. Percentages reported here are based on non-missing cases.
