


## National Indicators Florida State Data

FLORIDA BASELINE INDICATORS (as of December 2011)

NATIONAL INDICATOR 1: Education – Increase the proportion of employed nurses with a Baccalaureate in Nursing or Higher Degree to **80% by 2020**.

National Level Florida Level **49%** (as of 2010) **39.5%** (as of 2011)



NATIONAL INDICATOR 2: Doctoral Degrees – Double the number of nurses with a doctorate by 2020.



In Florida we are able to report actual numbers of nurses prepared at the doctoral level.

Nurses with a Nursing Doctorate = 320 Nurses with Other Doctorate Degree = 734 TOTAL Nurses with a doctorate = 1,054 (as of 2011)

NATIONAL INDICATOR 3: Removing Barriers to Practice and Care – Advanced practice nurses are able to practice to the full extent of their education and training.

Florida nurses continue to pursue expanded practice for Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioners.

NATIONAL INDICATOR 4: Interprofessional Collaboration – Expand opportunities for nurses to lead and disseminate collaborative improvement efforts.

Nationally among the 9 identified universities, only 6 clinical courses and/or activities were found to include both RN students and other graduate health professional students.

Florida data is not known.

NATIONAL INDICATOR 5: Leadership – Health care decision makers should ensure leadership positions are available to and filled by nurses.

As of 2011 < 10% of hospital boards have RN members.

Florida data is being collected as a part of the SIP Grant – *Promoting Nurse Leadership to Influence Nursing and Health Policy*.

## NATIONAL INDICATOR 6: Workforce Data – Build infrastructure for collection and analysis of interprofessional health care workforce data.

Number of nurse workforce data items recommended by the National Forum Minimum Nurse Supply Datasets that are collected by states.

33 states collect 1-11 items

17 states collect 12-14 items

Florida Center for Nursing collects more than the minimum survey items and completes data collection, analysis and reporting as follows:

- ➤ Nurse Supply Data collected as each licenses nurse completes license renewal; analyzed every two years.
- ➤ Nurse Demand Data biennial collection and reporting
- ➤ Nurse Education Data annual collection and reporting
