

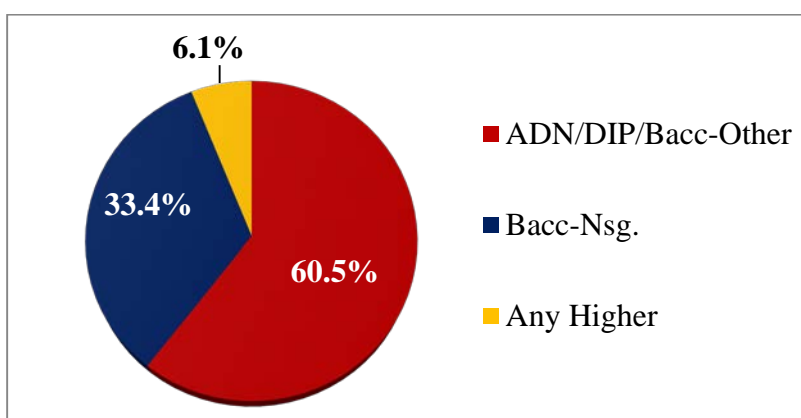

FLORIDA BASELINE INDICATORS (as of December 2011)

NATIONAL INDICATOR 1: Education – Increase the proportion of employed nurses with a Baccalaureate in Nursing or Higher Degree to 80% by 2020.

National Level 49% (as of 2010)
Florida Level 39.5% (as of 2011)



NATIONAL INDICATOR 2: Doctoral Degrees – Double the number of nurses with a doctorate by 2020.

Nurses with a Nursing Doctorate = 320
Nurses with Other Doctorate Degree = 734

Florida nurses continue to pursue expanded practice for Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioners.

Nationally among the 9 identified universities, only 6 clinical courses and/or activities were found to include both RN students and other graduate health professional students.

NATIONAL INDICATOR 5: Leadership – Health care decision makers should ensure leadership positions are available to and filled by nurses.

Florida data is being collected as a part of the SIP Grant – *Promoting Nurse Leadership to Influence Nursing and Health Policy*.

NATIONAL INDICATOR 6: Workforce Data – Build infrastructure for collection and analysis of interprofessional health care workforce data.

Number of nurse workforce data items recommended by the National Forum Minimum Nurse Supply Datasets that are collected by states.

33 states collect 1-11 items

17 states collect 12-14 items

Florida Center for Nursing collects more than the minimum survey items and completes data collection, analysis and reporting as follows:

- Nurse Supply Data – collected as each licenses nurse completes license renewal; analyzed every two years.
- Nurse Demand Data – biennial collection and reporting
- Nurse Education Data – annual collection and reporting
